SETTLEMENT OF CHARGES AGAINST J. ARON & COMPANY

Exchange Rule:

Exchange Rule 6.20(b) - Position Limits, Conditional Limits and Position Accountability for Energy Contracts

No Person may exceed the position limits specified in the Position Limit Table for any Energy Contract unless an exemption has been granted by the Exchange in accordance with these Rules.

Summary:

A subcommittee of the Exchange's Business Conduct Committee determined that J. Aron & Company ("J. Aron") may have violated Exchange Rule 6.20(b) in one instance by holding a position in excess of the applicable spot month positions limit. The subcommittee also noted that J. Aron self-reported the instance to the Exchange.

Penalty:

In accordance with the terms of settlement, in which J. Aron neither admitted nor denied the rule violations, J. Aron paid a monetary penalty of \$35,000.00 and agreed to cease and desist from future violations of Rules 6.20(b).
